VENUE: Stoke on Trent College, Burslem Campus

DURATION OF COURSE: 1 year

SELECTION CRITERIA:

- A real interest in the subject area
- A willingness to complete practical and written tasks
- An interview and assessment to confirm suitability for the course

There are no formal entry requirements for this course. You will have an interview/pre-induction assessment to make sure this is the right course for you.

BRIEF DETAILS OF COURSE:

This is an Art and Design course with a focus on Photography and Fashion. The course covers Fashion: history of fashion, deconstructed textiles, dyed fabrics, printed fabrics, fashion design, home textiles, stitched and embellished textiles and Photography: basic techniques, photography genres, documentary and photo journalism, landscape photography, experimental imagery, experimental imagery, moving images and a final project.

This course is taught through a combination of Vocational Studies (5.5 hours per week), English and Maths (3 hours per week), Work Experience (1.5 hours per week), Personal and Social Development (1 hour per week), Tutorial (1 hour per week).

MATHS & ENGLISH

All courses will include Maths and English. This part of the course will help you to improve your Maths and English skills and your friendly and experienced tutor will make sure the course uses everyday experience relevant to you.

HOW WILL I BE ASSESSED?

2 internally set portfolios - 1 for fashion (30%), 1 for photography (30%) and 1 externally set portfolio - mixed fashion/photo (40%)

PROGRESSION ROUTE:

You could move onto Entry 3 Creative Arts, Level 1 Creative Arts, Level 1 Performing Arts or another arts based course.
