BRIEF DETAILS OF COURSE:

This course covers an introduction to the construction industry. You will become accustomed to working in a workshop/site environment as well as developing an understanding of Health & Safety in the work environment.

You will learn the basics of Carpentry & Joinery including hand tools, hand tool skills, marking out, forming basic joints frames and timber objects.

There is a high importance of mature behaviour, attendance, punctuality and commitment on this course.

Safety footwear and yellow high visibility vest must be worn at all times.

MATHS & ENGLISH
