1 year

ENTRY CRITERIA :

- A real interest in the subject area
- A willingness to complete practical and written tasks
- An interview and assessment to confirm suitability for the course

BRIEF DETAILS OF COURSE:

This qualification is for young people who may be interested in a career in an area of the construction industry. It is particularly aimed at 16-18 year olds and provides the learner with basic skills in different areas of the construction industry including brickwork, carpentry and joinery with added core units for each trade. The course is a combination of practical and theory sessions and will enable students to progress onto a higher level college course or onto the first step of a career in the building industry with further training.

MATHS AND ENGLISH

All courses will include Maths and English. This part of the course will help you to improve your Maths and English skills—Your friendly and experienced tutor will make sure the course uses everyday experiences relevant to you.

HOW WILL I BE ASSESSED

There is no final examination—you will be assessed by carrying out practical assessments and you will learn through a combination of theory sessions, practical workshops and projects that will be set throughout the year.

PROGRESSION ROUTE

Once you have completed the course you might want to move onto a higher level study programme, a full time course such as Multi Trade or Apprenticeship course at Stoke on Trent College.
